PUBLICATION - MINOR CHILD'S NAME CHANGE

Purpose: Both parents are usually required to consent to a child's name change. If a parent will not consent, the parent must be <u>personally served</u> with a copy of the petition for name change and notice of name change. If you can't find the parent, a search must be done to try and locate him/her.

<u>Your goal is to find the parent and have him/her served!</u> However, if the person still cannot be found after the search, you can ask the judge for permission to serve the parent by: 1) mailing a copy of the summons and complaint to their last known address, <u>and</u> 2) publishing the notice in a newspaper for 3 weeks.

What Do I Have to Show to Get a Request for Publication Approved? There is no guaranteed way to get the Court to allow you to publish. Each case is different - the judge will look the overall efforts that have been made to find the parent to decide if enough has been done. You have to show that you have done everything possible to find the parent without any luck.

<u>1. Mail a Copy of the Petition for Name Change and the Notice of Petition</u> to the Parent's Last Known Address:

Mail a copy of the petition for name change AND the notice of petition for name change to the parent's last known address. This must be sent by *certified* or *registered* mail.

2. Fill out the Paperwork:

All Self Help forms are in a checkbox/fill in the blank format. Use black ink and write clearly. Fill out:

□ <u>Certificate of Mailing</u>

This form tells the judge when and where you mailed a copy of the documents to the parent. Affidavit for Service by Publication

This form tells the judge the last address for the parent, the date the parent last lived there, and the date you mailed a copy of the documents to that address. It is also your statement under penalty of perjury that you do not know where to find the parent.

□ <u>Affidavit of Due Diligence</u>

This form tells the judge everything that has been done to try to find the parent. The form includes many suggested search methods that may help you find the person. <u>It is best to have</u> someone else search for the parent and then fill out this form as a record of where they searched. If you find a possible address for the parent during the search, try to have him/her personally served.

Order for Service by Publication

The judge will sign this form if your request to serve the parent by publication is approved.

Many family law matters involve complex and valuable legal rights which cannot adequately be protected without the assistance of an attorney. The information provided is basic, general information that does not fit all situations. It is the duty of each self-represented individual to know what rules of court and law apply. <u>3. File Your Paperwork:</u>

- **In person:** Bring the documents listed above to the Family Courthouse. File them with the Clerk of Court. <u>All documents are electronically filed and will be emailed to you</u> after processing. You must provide a valid email address when filing.
- Online: You can upload your documents at <u>https://nevada.tylerhost.net/OfsWeb/</u>. You must register for an account, provide an email address, and you must be able to scan and upload your documents. There is a \$3.50 fee to e-file your documents. <u>The Order for Service by Publication cannot be filed online it must be mailed or brought to the courthouse.</u>

4. Submit Your Documents to the Judge:

Mail or Drop Off Your Paperwork:

- □ Bring the Order for Service by Publication and all of the paperwork you filed to the Family Courthouse (or mail it to 601 North Pecos, Las Vegas, NV 89101).
- \Box Take all of the paperwork to the 3rd floor.
- \Box Drop all of the paperwork in the box for your judge.

5. Wait for the Judge to Review Your Request:

The judge will review your papers, and if the judge believes that the parent truly cannot be found, the judge will sign your Order for Service by Publication. This can take 1-2 weeks. The judge's staff will contact you after it is signed, or will send it to you in the mail.

If there is a problem with your paperwork, you will receive a memo from the judge's staff letting you know what needs to be fixed. You will have to fix the problem and resubmit the Order.

<u>6. Publish the Notice of Petition to Change Minor's Name:</u>

Contact a Newspaper to Publish the Notice:

- □ You must arrange to have the Notice published for 3 consecutive weeks. Find out the publication cost directly from the newspaper. Newspapers commonly used are:
 - o Nevada Legal News, (702) 382-2747
 - o Review-Journal and Sun, (702) 383-0383
- □ Give the newspaper a copy of your Order to Serve by Publication and a copy of the Notice of Petition to Change Minor's Name.
- □ The newspaper will usually file an Affidavit of Publication once complete. If they do not, be sure to bring the affidavit to the courthouse for filing.
- □ You must wait until 20 days after the last date the notice was published to do anything else. This is the period of time the other parent has to file an objection if they want to oppose the name change. If the parent does not file anything in that time, you can take the final steps to finish the case. Refer to your original instructions for what to do next.
