
Bracelet/Necklace Optional

A person who is not in a hospital, nursing home or licensed hospice and has an order not to resuscitate **may** wear an identifying bracelet on either the wrist or the ankle or an identifying necklace and shall post or place a prominent notice in the person's home or residence to provide notice of the order not to resuscitate.

If such bracelet or necklace is worn, it shall be substantially similar to identification bracelets worn in hospitals and shall provide the following information in boldface type:

"DO NOT RESUSCITATE ORDER

Patient's name: _____

Authorized person's name and telephone number, if applicable:

Patient's physician's printed name and telephone number:

Date of order not to resuscitate: _____"

Liability for persons carrying out a DNR order:

No authorized person, health care facility or other licensed facility or their employee acting as an agent for them is subject to any criminal or civil liability for carrying out a DNR order in good faith as long as it was carried out in compliance with the standards and procedures set forth in the law; nor, shall they be subject to civil or criminal liability for providing cardiopulmonary resuscitation to a patient for whom an order not to resuscitate has been issued provided that such physician or person reasonably and in good faith was unaware of the order or believed consent was revoked.
